Problem 1 (40 pts)

You need to create a webpage to find the details of any user from the auction database used for Project 2 part 1. Your webpage should have the same functionality as of the following link:

http://betaweb.csug.rochester.edu/~tbiswas2/class_demo/q8/find_user.html

You provide the UserID and click submit, and you get the UserID, Rating, Location, and Country of the User. It reports if the UserID is not present.

Note:

- If you cannot access the site, that means you are not connected to the UR network. Please use VPN.
- Some sample userIDs are, “!peanut”, “\$303”, “*json*”, “-tati-” (without the quotes). You can use these userIDs for testing. Yes, these IDs are weird!
- You must use PHP and MySQL in the back-end.

Submission

You do not need to submit any file, but your website should be up and running by the due date. The web-address of the html file should be:

http://betaweb.csug.rochester.edu/~YOUR_NETID/q8.html

(Note: Do not miss the tilde (~) symbol before your netid)

To achieve this, on the betaweb server, your file should be saved as: `~/public_html/q8.html`. We do not need the link to the PHP file.

Using .css files is optional for this quiz though you are welcome to do so.
